

Frequently Asked Questions

Do I have to pay to come into Water World if I do not plan to swim?

Yes, each person that comes into the park must pay the admission fee. This fee includes use of picnic tables, restrooms, lounge chairs, etc.

Do I have to wear a swimsuit?

Yes, swimwear is required in all pools and on slides. T-shirts and elastic waistband shorts are permitted over swimwear. In order to preserve the pools and slides, no buttons, zippers, studs, belts, or cutoffs are allowed.

Do you give refunds or rainchecks?

Water World sometimes must temporarily shut down while a lightning storm passes near the park. All customers are asked to exit the pools and slides and take shelter in the game room or under the concession stand. As soon as the storm passes, we re-open the pools & slides. Refunds and rainchecks are not given under these circumstances.

Can I bring food and drinks into Water World?

Food and drinks are allowed in the park. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed. We ask that guests do not take their food/drinks onto the carpet around the wavepool. Don't forget about the mouth-watering concession stand!

Are inflatables allowed in Water World?

No inflatable or Styrofoam flotation devices are allowed at Water World for customer safety. We do allow Coast Guard certified life jackets, which are available at Wal-Mart. We also rent life jackets at the tube rental station.

Is Water World handicapped accessible?

Yes, the majority of Water World is handicapped accessible. Certain attractions are not. For further information, please contact us at (334) 615-3755.

Can I smoke in Water World?

Smoking in Water World is only allowed within the designated smoking area. Smoking is not permitted outside of this area.
